Installing the Brush

Parts needed for this procedure:


1	Brush
2	Screw
2	Capscrew
2	Clamp

Procedure

- 1. Remove the plow bolt, washer and nut securing one of the height of cut (HOC) arms to the cutting unit side plate (Figure 1).
- 2. Loosen the roller mounting screws in the HOC arms (Figure 1).
- 3. Slide the HOC arm off the roller shaft (Figure 1).
- 4. Slide the roller shaft out of the HOC arm on the opposite end of the cutting unit.








1. Adjusting screw

- HOC arm 2. 3. Plow bolt
- 6.
- Roller mounting screw
- Loosely install a capscrew and nut onto each 5. clamp (Figure 2). Do not tighten.
- Insert a shaft clamp onto each end of the roller 6. shaft (Figure 2).
- Loosely install the roller to the cutting unit with 7. the HOC arm and fasteners previously removed.
- Adjust to the desired height of cut and tighten 8. HOC arm mounting fasteners.
- Position the brush between the front roller and 9. the cutting unit as shown in Figure 2.



Center the brush on the roller. 10.

- Move the scraper in or out until the desired roller 11. clearance is attained. The scraper must not contact the roller. Ensure that the scraper is parallel to the roller.
- Tighten the capscrews and nuts securing the 12. clamps to the roller shaft. Torque to 11 N·m (96 in-lbs).
- 13. Center the roller and brush between the HOC arms.
- Rotate the brush down until the desired turf 14. contact is attained.
- Tighten the roller mounting screws. 15.
