Parts needed for this procedure:

1	Hood
2	Flat washer
12	Screw self tapping 1/4 x 0.75

Procedure

- 1. Raise the existing hood (Figure 1).
- 2. Disconnect the wire harness located on the left side.
- 3. Remove the 4 screws securing the hood to the frame. Remove the hood. Save these screws.




- 1. Raised hood
- 2. Wire harness
- 3. Frame
- 4. Screws securing the hood
- 4. Remove the 4 screws securing the air duct to the existing hood. Remove the air duct and discard screws (Figure 2).



1. Air duct

- 6. Outside screw securing the headlight (save these existing screws)
- 2. Self tapping screw
- Self tapping screw securing the trim and the front end assembly

3. Trim

- Inside screw securing the headlight (discard these screws)
- 4. Self tapping screw securing the trim (install the new flat washers here)
- 9. Front end assembly
- 5. Headlight
- 5. Remove the 6 screws securing the trim and front end assembly. Discard the screws and remove the trim.
- 6. Remove the 2 outside screws securing the headlights. Save these screws.
- 7. Remove the 2 inside screws and discard the screws.
- 8. Remove the head lights and front end assembly.
- 9. Install the existing air duct to the new hood using the 4 new self-tapping screws.
- 10. Install the existing trim, headlights, and front grill assembly to the new hood using the 2 new flat washers, 8 new self tapping screws, and two existing screws securing the outside area of the head lights.

Note: Install the new self-tapping screws only in places that thread directly into the hood. Use the existing hardware in the other areas.

- 11. Tighten all of the screws securing the air duct, trim, front end assembly, and headlights to 20–28 in-lb.
- 12. Install the new hood to the frame using the existing screws.
- 13. Install the wire harness.
- 14. Close the hood.
